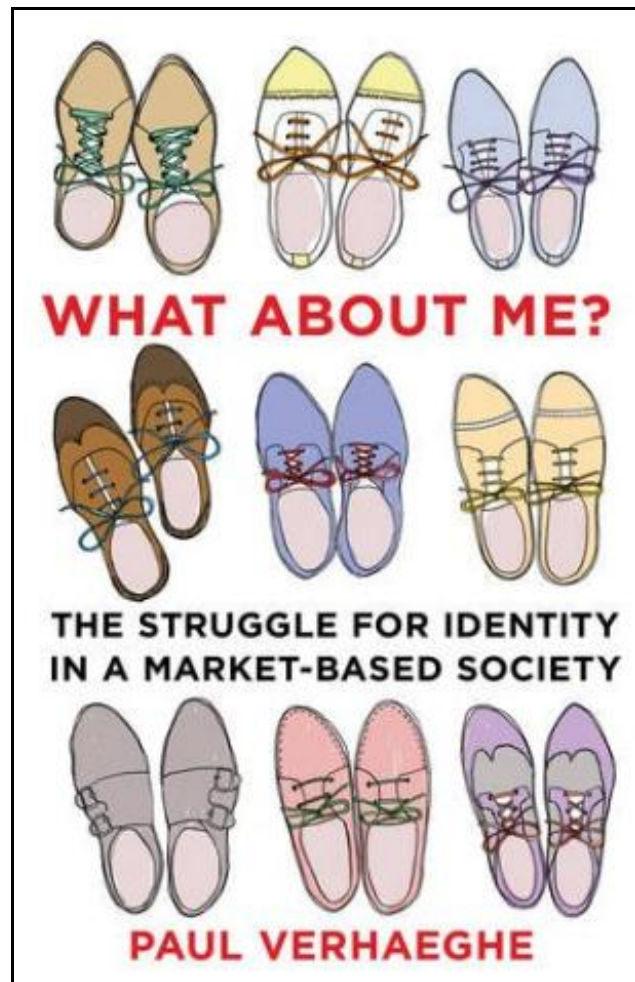

But his book ends on a note of cautious optimism. Can we once again become masters of our fate?.
