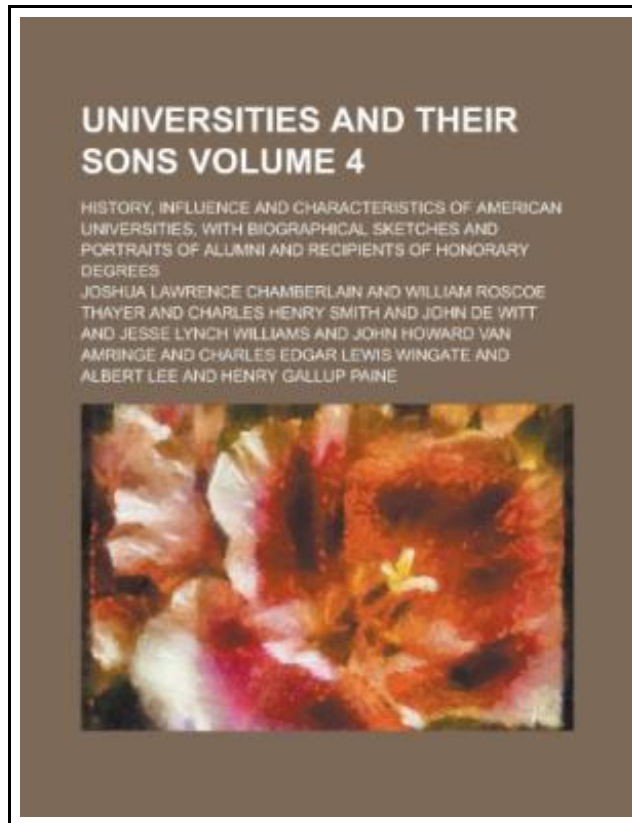

College of Physicians and Surgeons of Columbia, 1862; House Physician in Colored Home Hospital, New York City, for one and a half years; engaged in active practice in Troy, N. Y. , since 1863; Superintendent of Marshall Infirmary since 1863; Vice-President of St. Stephens Guild and Editor of its Paper. JOSEPH DODSON LOMAX, M. D. , Physician, was born in Bolton, England, son of John and Anna (Dodson) Lomax. His ancestors were well-to-do people and took an active part in the life of their native town. His father was a bookbinder and printer who came to New York in the thirties. He invented wood-letter cutting, and his work became so popular in the trade that it was in universal use at the time of his death. Dr. Lomax received his early education in private schools; he studied medicine at the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Columbia, and was graduated in 1862. Immediately after graduation he entered the Colored Home, and after a term of service as House Physician in the Hospital connected with it, removed to Troy where he engaged in active practice. In October of 1863 he received the appointment of Medical Superintendent of Marshall Infirmary, at Troy, New York, which position he still holds. He has always taken an...
